SUBJECT: Uniform, SOP 355.

1. REFERENCE:
None.

2. GENERAL
This SOP describes the proper wear of the VDF uniform.

3. PURPOSE
To promote the correct wear of the uniform.

4. SCOPE
This SOP is applicable to all personnel assigned to, attached to, or under the control of the Commander.

5. RESPONSIBILITY
Commanders and staff are responsible for assuring compliance with this SOP.

6. STANDARDS

Wear, Generally.

Wear of the uniform is permitted for all VDF authorized activities—unless otherwise specified. Uniforms must be in good repair, fit correctly, and present a good appearance. Uniforms should never be worn at political events or demonstrations unless permission is granted by the Battalion Commander in writing.

Weight & Wear Goals

The following chart is based on Air Force Regulation that is flexible, simple and unisex. The 10% percentage reflects the maximum weight goal for VDF members.
